What is Uveitis?

- Persistent inflammation of the eye
- May have infectious or immune-mediated cause
- One of the leading causes of blindness in the United States
- Occurs most frequently in the 25-44 year age group

Common Symptoms of Uveitis:

- Vision Loss
- Eye pain
- Blurred vision
- Redness of the eye

The LX211-11 Protocol:

If you or someone you know has been diagnosed with noninfectious uveitis, you/they may be eligible to participate in the LX211-11 Clinical Research Program, investigating a potential new therapy to treat noninfectious uveitis. Participants will receive study-related care and medication at no cost for the 26-week duration of the study.

Participants must:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Weigh at least 38kg or 84 lbs
