



# SOLAR ECLIPSE SAFETY TIPS

## KEEP YOUR EYES SAFE DURING THE ECLIPSE

### Use solar eclipse viewers.



Ensure eclipse glasses or viewers meet ISO 12312-2. Check for damage before use, and create a pinhole projector if you don't have eclipse glasses or viewers.

### Do not remove viewers while looking at the sun.



Put eclipse glasses or viewers on before observing the eclipse. After viewing, turn away from the sun before removing your glasses or viewers.

## Wear viewers over your regular glasses.



Put your solar eclipse glasses over your regular glasses, or hold your viewer in front of them.

### Do not look through a telescope or binoculars.



Using any such device can cause serious eye injury.
